Directions
<p>The Principal Race Officer (PRO) is generally the skipper of the boat signed up for RC for the night. All other people on the RC boat who help in any manner should be recorded under the "Other RC" field. The PRO is in charge and takes the lead for assigning the roles and responsibilities of the other RC helpers.</p> <p>Please be sure to fill in all fields on the scratch sheet with the exception of course distance. I can calculate course distance after the race given the exact course. If you do not use one of the courses defined in the SI, record "RCS:" followed by the specific marks of the course, any gates, and the directions of rounding. Please do not set a course that crosses unnavigable waters (...or land), this makes exact course distance calculation impossible.</p> <p>Use the scoring codes below as needed when recording results. If a competitor retires, please record the time of retirement next to the code.</p> <p>After the race, please take a nice, legible, photo of the completed scratch sheet and e-mail it to racing@sagamoreyc.com. If you can get me (Jonah) the actual sheet after the race at the club, depending on the course, I can often input the data and publish the result the same night.</p> <p><u>WNR Scoring Codes</u></p> <p>DNC Did not start; did not come to the starting area; no need to code this on the scratch sheet, I assume all unscored (blank entry) boats were DNC</p> <p>DNS Did not start (other than DNC and OCS); For WNR, this only applies to a boat that checks-in, does not withdraw prior to the beginning of the starting sequence, and subsequently does not start the race (for whatever reason). If a boat has an issue (e.g. something breaks, etc.) after checking-in but withdraws prior to the warning, then code them DNC, or just leave unscored. We do not penalize anyone for that situation.</p> <p>OCS Did not start; on the course side of the starting line at her starting signal and failed to start (i.e. did not come back behind the line and then continue to race), or broke rule 30.1</p> <p>NSC Did not sail the course.</p> <p>DNF Did not finish (technically should never happen as everyone should inform the RC if they are retiring) – there is an extra penalty if they didn't and are scored DNF.</p> <p>RET Retired</p> <p>TLE Time limit expired</p> <p>RC Used to indicate the boat that is providing RC for that night</p>
