Every regular member must obtain a **Membership Certificate**. This certificate entitles the member to all rights, privileges, and benefits as described in the SYC By-Laws. The certificate may be paid when joining or deferred until the second year of membership. It is refunded when you leave the club and a new member enters and purchases a Membership Certificate. The current value of the Certificate is \$850.

All members will be billed an additional \$120 on July 1, 2025 toward a fund for our replacement bulkhead. Sagamore is required to collect sales tax (8.625%) for all of the above.

The Capital Improvement Fund is paid by every member annually.

All new members, including former members returning to SYC, pay the initiation fee.

All memberships are for the calendar year and renew on January 1 of each year.

New Regular members pay a food minimum of \$75; New House members pay \$150, 12 months per year.

Dues and fees are only paid after the new member's application is fully approved by the club Board of Trustees. Sagamore uses a club management system known as Clubspot and payment is made electronically using a checking account or credit card. There is a fee for using credit cards
